

Funding sources

The following organizations have funding programs that can assist Alberta's urban municipalities in creating more sustainable transportation systems.

Program	Source Organization	Description
GreenTRIP Program (Green Transit Incentives Program)	Government of Alberta - Transportation	<p>Cost-shared funding program available to municipalities to support local priorities to provide sustainable public transit alternatives. Eligible initiatives include the development and construction of local, regional and inter-municipal capital public transit projects.</p> <p>The Green Transit Incentives Program is available to the owner/operator of public transit services, which may include municipalities, regional entities/authorities, non-profit organizations, and the private sector.</p>
Basic Municipal Transportation Grant (BMTG)	Government of Alberta - Transportation	<p>Provides financial assistance for developing and maintaining capital transportation infrastructure requirements, promoting economic growth, and improving quality of community life.</p> <p>Municipalities are eligible to receive an annual formula-based grant for capital construction and rehabilitation of local transportation infrastructure including roads, bridges, and public transit.</p>
Municipal Sustainability Initiative (MSI) - Capital	Government of Alberta - Municipal Affairs	<p>All municipalities in Alberta are eligible for MSI capital funding based on their grant allocation.</p> <p>Eligible projects include municipal roads, bridges, public transit, water and wastewater systems, emergency services facilities and equipment, solid waste management facilities and equipment, and other municipal buildings and facilities such as recreation and sports facilities, libraries, public works buildings, and cultural/community centres.</p>

<p>Federal Gas Tax Fund</p>	<p>Administered by Government of Alberta - Transportation</p>	<p>Program provides financial assistance to municipalities in support of sustainable capital municipal infrastructure.</p> <p>Eligible projects include the development of public transit systems, and water and wastewater systems, solid waste management, community energy systems, and community capacity building.</p> <p>There is no requirement for a municipal funding contribution to projects accepted under this program.</p>
